



ParaGard

Type: Intrauterine contraceptive (IUC)

How it works: ParaGard is a hormone-free IUC made of plastic and copper. It releases a tiny amount of copper which acts as spermicide to prevent pregnancy.

Effectiveness at preventing pregnancy: 99.2-99.4%

Lasts for up to: 12 years

Mirena

Type: Intrauterine contraceptive (IUC)

How it works: Mirena is plastic IUD that releases a small amount of the synthetic hormone progestin to prevent sperm from reaching the cervix Effectiveness at preventing pregnancy: 99.9%

Lasts for up to: 5 years

Skvla

Type: Intrauterine contraceptive (IUC)

How it works: Skyla is the smallest plastic IUC available. It releases a small amount of the synthetic hormone progestin to help

keep sperm from reaching your cervix

Effectiveness at preventing pregnancy: >99%

Lasts for up to: 3 years

Implanon

Type: Implant

How it works: Implanon is a tiny plastic rod about the size of a matchstick that releases hormones to prevent pregnancy. It's inserted into the inner part of the upper arm by a clinician.

Effectiveness at preventing pregnancy: >99%

Lasts for up to: 3 years
